PROJECT: Pike River, Mt. Pleasant, Wisconsin

DESCRIPTION: The Pike River is located approximately 4 miles west of Racine, Wisconsin and approximately 20 miles south-southwest of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The Upper Pike River is a rapidly urbanizing watershed with substantial urban and agricultural lands. The river exhibits flashy and powerful discharges with significant aggradation and degradation of the streambed and the surrounding wetlands. Bank stability is low and there is high potential for erosion events during high flow conditions. The purpose of the project is to restore natural stream features and wetlands in selected reaches, enhance aquatic habitat, and improve storm water quality and overall water quality.
