
2008 NAIP Post-Mortem Meeting November 19, 2008






- 5 year ('07-'11) Indefinite Delivery,
   Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) type contract
  - 2008 Task Order was the second year
- Contracts competed using "best value" procurement process
- Performance Based Contract: defines end product rather than <u>how to</u> produce the product
- Awarded in May 2007 to 6 contractors










#### 2008 NAIP ABSOLUTE VS RELATIVE CONTROL


#### 2008 NAIP SHAPE FILE TYPE







#### **2008 NAIP IMAGERY STATUS**





#### NAIP 2008 DOQQ Acquisition Date vs Flying Seasons












