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NAIP 2002-2007

- Annual coverage
 - 2 meter resolution
 - CLU coverage only
- "Base" replacement on 5 year cycle
 - GIS base imagery
 - Graphic for heads up digitizing, image interpretation
 - 1 meter resolution
 - Full state coverage
 - Accuracy spec relative to existing orthos

NAIP 2002-2007

- Inconsistent funding
 - Full funding only happened once 2006.
- 2 meter imagery had limited use
 - For FSA "for Compliance only"
 - If it was flown too early or too late, or delivered too late, imagery couldn't be used for compliance
 - Change on how FSA does "compliance"
 - Ag areas only

- 3 year cycle for "base" imagery
 - Cost share model based on core (minimum)
 FSA requirements and fiscal realities
 - Build in more stability and consistency
 - -1 meter
 - Continually improve quality
 - Transition to better accuracy specification


- 3 year cycle for "base" imagery
 - Represents FSA (core) minimum requirements
 - 3 year cycle
 - Natural color
 - 1 meter resolution
 - Agricultural coverage
 - Cost share model based on FSA core requirements
 - Cost Share partners pay for non-ag coverage
 - Buy-up to 4 band

- 3 year cycle for "base" imagery
 - Build in more stability and consistency
 - Stable funding target for partners
 - Enable better planning
 - Contractors
 - APFO
 - Partners

- 3 year cycle for "base" imagery
 - Continually improve quality
 - Transition to better accuracy specification
 - Lot's of interest in 4 band
 - Mosaic "seam line" shape file is valuable to FSA

- 3 year cycle for "base" imagery
 - Transition to better accuracy specification
 - Cautiously optimistic
 - May be problematic in some regions
