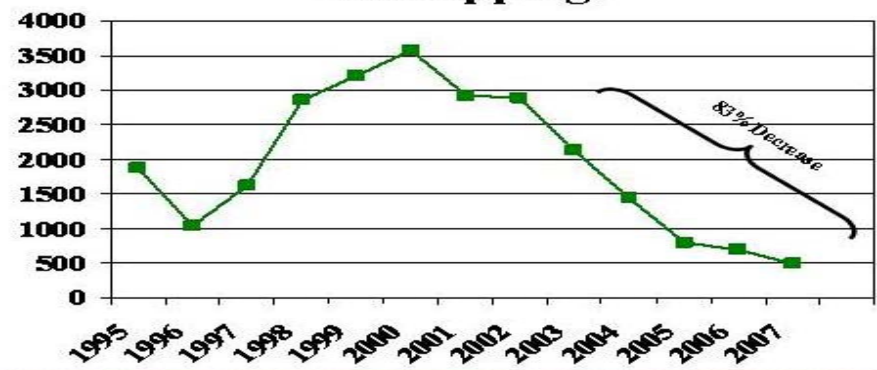

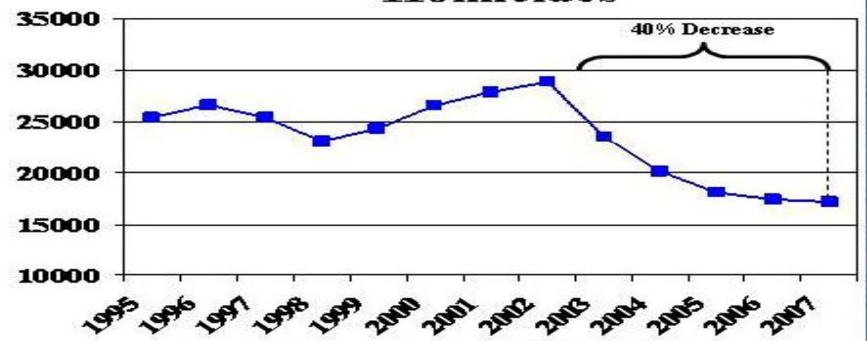
## Dramatic improvement in Colombia's security

- Terrorist attacks down 76%

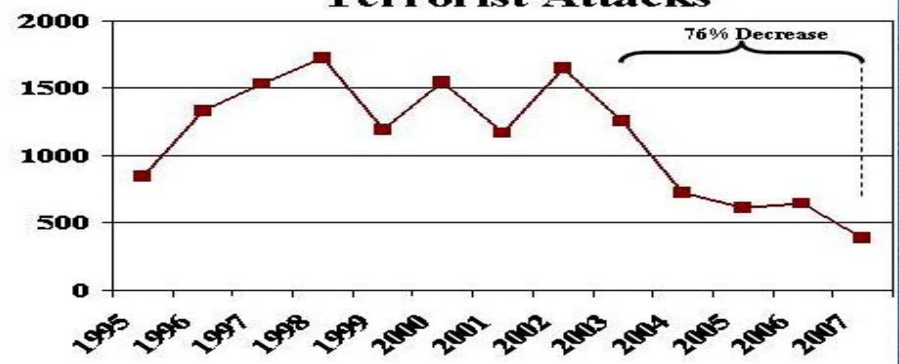

### Homicides



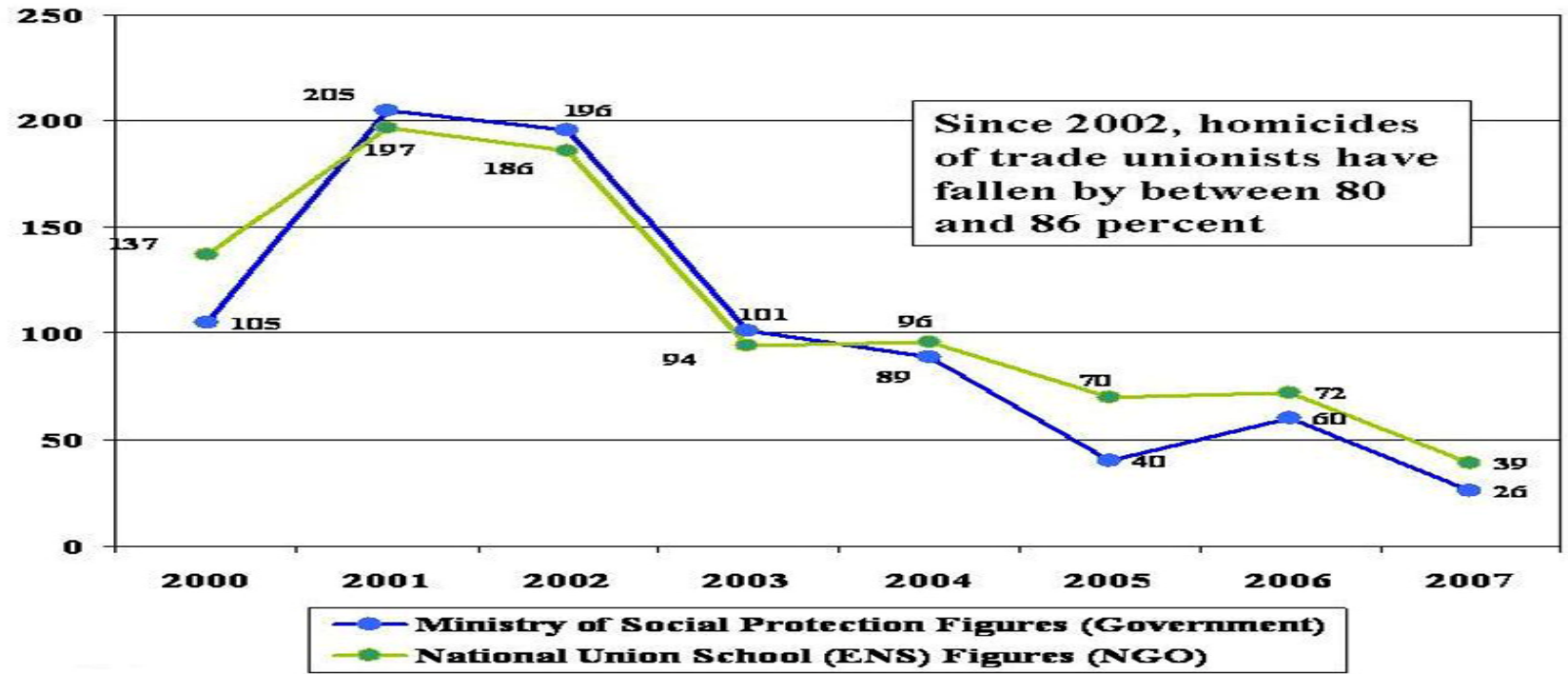

## Homicides of Trade Unionists in Colombia



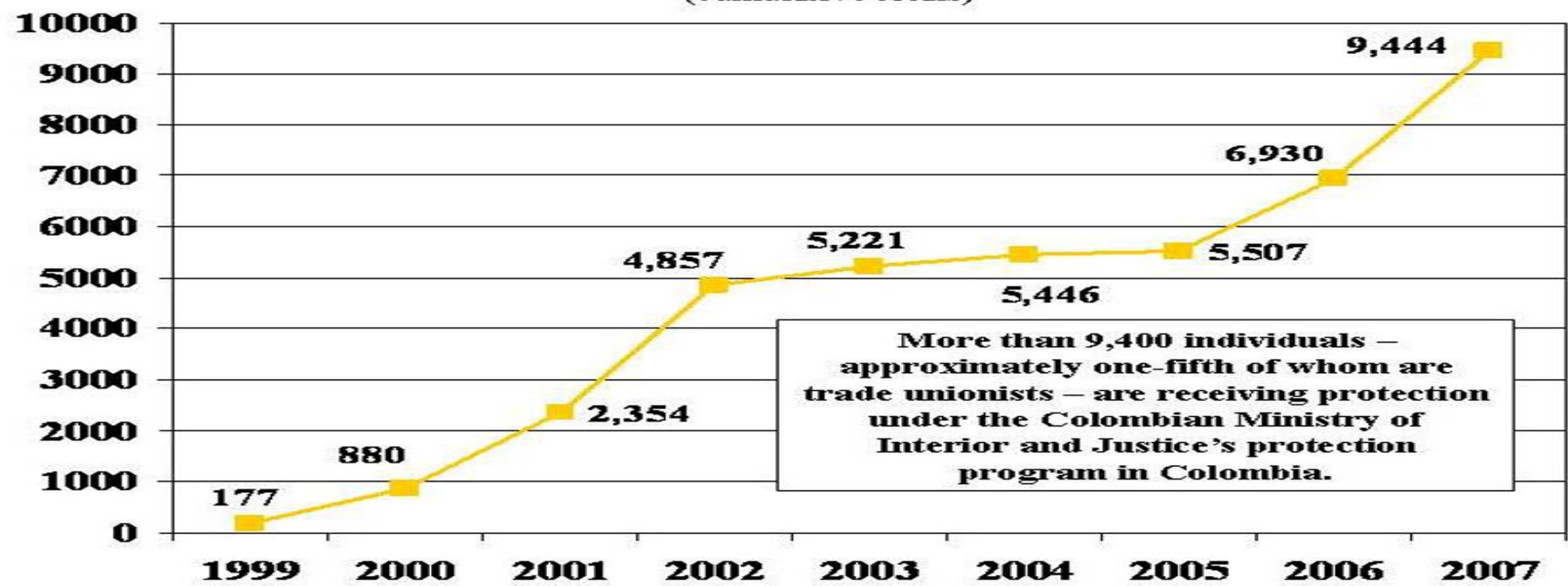

(cumulative totals)



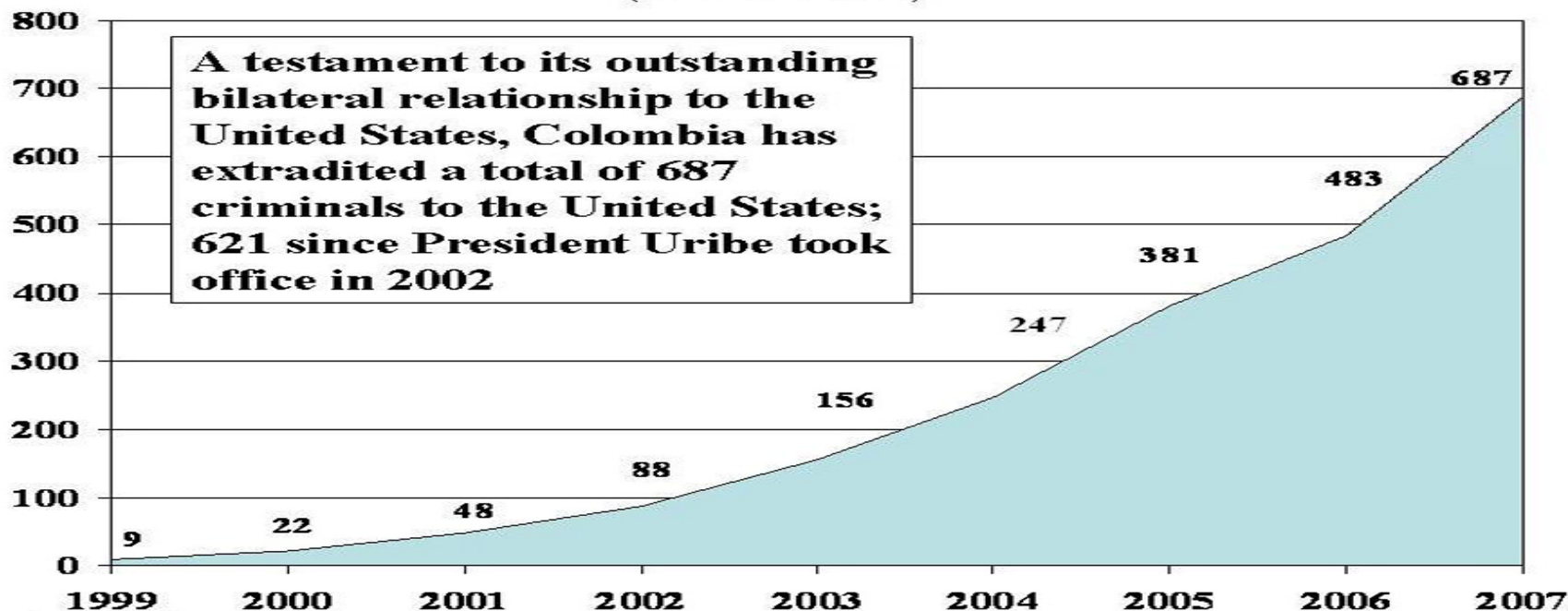
