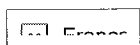


**DECLARATION – CANADIAN PROVINCE OF NEW BRUNSWICK
RECIPROCITY IN FAMILY SUPPORT (MAINTENANCE) ENFORCEMENT**

As authorized by section 459A (a) (1) of Title IV-D of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. § 659A (a) (1), and with the concurrence of the Secretary of Health and Human Services, I hereby declare the Province of New Brunswick, a political subdivision of Canada, a "foreign reciprocating country" effective on the date of a corresponding declaration by the Province of New Brunswick.

Under subsection 43(1) of the *Interjurisdictional Support Orders Act*, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council makes the following Regulation:

Citation

1 This Regulation may be cited as the *Reciprocating Jurisdictions Regulation - Interjurisdictional Support Orders Act*.

Definition of "Act"

2 In this Regulation, "Act" means the *Interjurisdictional Support Orders Act*.

Reciprocating jurisdictions

3 The following are designated to be reciprocating jurisdictions for the purposes of the Act:

(a) the following Provinces and Territories of Canada:

- (i) Alberta;
- (ii) British Columbia;
- (iii) Manitoba;
- (iv) Newfoundland;
- (v) Northwest Territories;
- (vi) Nova Scotia;
- (vii) Nunavut;
- (viii) Ontario;
- (ix) Prince Edward Island;
- (x) Quebec;
- (xi) Saskatchewan; and

- (xii) Yukon Territory;
- (b) the following States and Territories of Australia:
 - (i) New South Wales;
 - (ii) Queensland;
 - (iii) South Australia;
 - (iv) Tasmania;
 - (v) Victoria; and
 - (vi) Western Australia;
- (c) Austria;
- (d) Bermuda;
- (e) England;
- (f) Federal Republic of Germany;
- (g) Fiji;
- (h) Isle of Man;
- (i) New Zealand;
- (j) Northern Ireland;
- (k) Republic of Poland;
- (l) Republic of Trinidad and Tobago;
- (m) Scotland;
- (n) Singapore; and
- (o) the United States of America, including the fifty States, American Samoa, District of Columbia, Guam, Puerto Rico, United States Virgin Islands and any other jurisdiction of the United States of America participating in Title IV-D of the *Social Security Act* (United States of America).

Commencement

4 *This Regulation comes into force on February 1, 2004.*
