- INDEF** = The FV Indicator remains on the protected person's SCR record for an indefinite period of time.
- TIMED** = The FV Indicator remains on the protected person's SCR record for a specific length of time.
- UNDEC** = The State has not decided the FV Indicator term at this point.
- VICTIM** = The victim may request removal and/or indicate to the agency or court that the violence has ended.
- PO END** = The FV Indicator is removed when the protection order expires.

Matrix 5 – Notes

- (1) Florida will set an FV Indicator for up to 45 days, based on an oral self-report. The longer indicator, based on a written report, is indefinite.
- (2) Illinois' current Good Cause Indicator is kept indefinitely. It is unclear how long other indicators will remain in place.
