The indicator field is set either as a "blank" when there is no indication of risk, or it is set as a "Y" when there is a known risk of harm.*

Subj: Family Violence and SSN verified fields

Beginning this month, the CSED will send extracts of child support cases to the Federal Case Registry to proactively match against information in the expanded Federal Parent Locator Service. This information will also be available to other IV-D agencies and other authorized persons. In preparation for this, two new fields are being added to case tracking. These are the Family Violence indicator and the SSN verified indicator. These fields are currently in production on the add/modify Case Management screens. Eventually they will be present in some form on the Regional screens. The purpose of these screens is as follows:

* * *

Family Violence Indicator (FVI) -- This field indicates that the CSED has reasonable evidence that the individual has been a victim of family violence. It DOES NOT NECESSARILY mean that the NCP is the perpetrator of family violence. The presence of a "Y" in this field will preclude the Federal Case Registry/expanded FPLS from releasing any information on that individual without an order from a court requiring the release. This is intended to protect victims of family violence from unintended release of information. It is possible for an NCP to also be a victim of family violence. At a minimum, a State must place an indicator on a case if there is a protection order in the State. The CSED has cross-referenced all protection orders in the State against Case Tracking and has updated the FVI indicator as appropriate.
