SETTING CRITERIA: IV-D & Non IV-D--
Restraining order or protection order

ELIGIBLE PEOPLE: People Directly Protected --
Victims

Others Protected --
All household members involved in the victim's TN child support cases or orders (Automatic)

IMPACT: Sends FV Indicator to the FCR

DURATION: Time-Limited

REMOVAL CRITERIA: Expiration of protection order

OVERRIDE: State-specific components not yet developed

SUBJECT: SCR Family Violence Indicator and Locate Interfaces

Sections 452(A) and Section 453(h) of Title IV-D of the Social Security Act and Tennessee Code Annotated 36-5-115, provides for the nondisclosure of case information if there has been reasonable evidence of domestic violence or child abuse. A Family Violence indicator is required in the State Case Registry (SCR) for submittal to the Federal Case Registry (FCR).

Implementing the Family Violence (FV) Indicator

When a IV-D case is submitted to the FCR and family violence exists either through an order of protection or a restraining order, a[n] FV indicator will be placed on the member(s) affected by family violence (usually the CP and child(ren)) to prevent the release of information. Once the FV indicator is set on the member(s) in the SCR, it will be transmitted to the FCR. This will notify OCSE not to disclose location information on persons which have been designated with a FAM VIOL indicator as being in need of protection.

If more than one state places an FV indicator on the same person the FCR does not release any information on that person until all states have removed the FV indicator for that person. States cannot remove the FV designation placed on the FCR by another state.

The DEMO screen on TCSES has been modified to allow TCSES users to "Update" to indicate that Family Violence exists for member(s) and/or to remove the Family Violence indicator for member(s) when appropriate. A new field, "FAM VIOL", near the bottom of the DEMO screen enables the User to add or update the family violence indicator for a member. Attached is the revised DEMO screen which includes a member based Family Violence indicator (FAM VIOL).

CLERKS OF COURT AND THE STATE CASE REGISTRY

I. INTRODUCTION

Effective 10/1/98, states are required to have a State Case Registry -- **SCR**. The **SCR** contains information on IV-D child support cases and information on all Non IV-D cases for which support orders are established or modified on or after 10/1/98.

SCR files will be routinely submitted to the Federal Case Registry -- **FCR** -- with new cases and changes to cases previously submitted to the **FCR**. The **FCR** is a national information resource to locate parents, employers and other information to aid in the establishment and enforcement of child support. Information provided by the **SCR** to the **FCR** will be matched against other states[,] information and other data bases for the purpose of providing this information to the states who have an interest in the information.

The **SCR** is maintained on Tennessee's statewide automated child support system -- **TCSES** [--] and information is forwarded to the **FCR** from **TCSES**.

Information for the **SCR** includes:

- ☛ Name of NCP, CP, and Dependent Child(ren) -- there must be at least one child.
- ☛ Type of Case (IVD or non IVD).
- ☛ Date of Birth or Social Security Number.
- ☛ Family Violence Indicator (If there is family violence indicated on a case, the **FCR** will not share information with other parties in an effort to prevent future violence).

Family Violence should be indicated if:

- There is a[n] Order of Protection on the case
- There is a Restraining Order in the Final Decree Of Divorce.

ATTACHMENT B

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING THE NIVD SCREENS
FOR TCSES CLERKS AND CENTRAL OFFICE STAFF**

The NIVD screens are used to enter information on Non-IV-D support orders established or modified on or after 10/1/98 into TCSES to create a non IV-D case for the purpose of providing the required information for the State Case Registry. Any changes reported by the parties to the order must als [sic] to the The [sic] **NIVD** screens will be used by:

- ☛ TCSES clerks to enter information on Non IV-D orders established or modified in their court[s] on or after 10/1/98.
- ☛ Central office child support staff to enter information on Non IV-D orders required by the State Case Registry into TCSES from information they receive on the demographic sheets or orders faxed to them by the Opt Out Clerks.

The screen may not be used to enter a IV-D case as any case entered will be created as a non IV-D case.

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Entering Non IV-D Order Information on TCSES by Using the Non IV-D Screens

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Family Violence Indicator

The “Family Violence” indicator is recorded and tracked for each individual member and should be used if appropriate so that information on the member will not be shared by the **FCR**.

The Family Violence Indicator should be used when:

- ☛ There is an Order of Protection on the case[.]
- ☛ There is a restraining provision in the Final Order of Divorce[.]

The valid codes for the “Family Violence Ind” field are:

- ☛ ‘FV’ -- family violence Indicated for this member
- ☛ ‘XX’ -- family violence removed for this member
- ☛ Spaces -- no change in family violence status[.]

Currently, the **NIVD** screens can be used to add a Family Violence Indicator only at the point of initial entry of the case. Any subsequent Family Violence Indicator changes that are needed after the case is established on TCSES, will be updated on the TCSES DEMO screen. More information will be provided concerning the Family Violence Indicator and procedure to update the DEMO screen when family violence exists.
