PURPOSE: The purpose of this Information Memorandum is to provide States with a self-

assessment tool and the option to use it as a guide to review their State's compliance

with the Federal requirements of the title IV-E adoption assistance program.

INFORMATION: The title IV-E adoption assistance program self-assessment was developed by the

Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families, Children's Bureau (CB), to provide a process by which State title IV-E agencies may voluntarily review their title IV-E adoption assistance programs for consistency with Federal requirements. The self-assessment tool is intended only for internal use by State title IV-E agencies. This tool is *not* a Federal requirement and States are *not*

required to complete it.

We encourage the State to consult with its appropriate CB Regional Office to address questions or concerns regarding State implementation of the title IV-E adoption

assistance requirements.
