
Distribution of Total Days Lost by Accident Class Underground Mining Operations, 2002-2006 (n=924,692)

NOTES: (1) Total days lost were computed by taking the higher of either the "Statutory Days Away from Work" or the combined "Actual Days Away from Work" plus the "Days of Restricted Work Activity." (2) "Fall of ground (from in place)" includes MSHA's Accident/Injury/Illness classifications for "Fall of face, rib, pillar, side, or highwall (from in place)" and "Fall of roof, back, or brow (from in place)." (3) Nonfatal injury cases occurring underground and classified under "Machinery" were reclassified as a "Fall of ground (from in place)" if the source of the injury was "Caving rock, ore, etc." This reclassification is consistent with how MSHA classifies similar incidents which resulted in a fatal injury. (4) Sum of percentages may not equal 100 due to independent rounding.
