
## Distribution of Lost-time Injuries by Accident Class Underground Mining Operations, 2002-2006 (n=14,388)

(2) Nonfatal injury cases occurring underground and classified under "Machinery" were reclassified as a "Fall of ground (from in place)" if the source of the injury was "Caving rock, ore, etc." This reclassification is consistent with how MSHA classifies similar incidents which resulted in a fatal injury.
