
Figure 9-1. Work-related asthma: Most frequently reported agent categories associated with cases of work-related asthma, 1993-1999

The category 'Miscellaneous Chemicals' accounts for a large range of exposures including pesticides, perfume, enzymes, and odors; 'Mineral and Inorganic Dust' includes exposures such as plaster, fiberglass, and cement; 'Indoor Air Pollutants' includes pollutants from building renovation; 'Pyrolysis Products' includes smoke and diesel exhaust; 'Solvents' includes paint and paint thinners; 'Hydrocarbons' includes cutting oils; and 'Polymers' includes natural rubber latex.
