The prohibition on circumvention of technological measures that protect "access" to copyrighted works is adversely affecting identifiable noninfringing uses of that class of works, like making backup copies so that when the work wear out, I can use a backup copy.

Same is true of professionally shot digital photographs that are on cheap disks that fail in a few years.
