obtained as a bonus when purchasing a limited edition plastic model kit that
has not been offered in the USA of present time. Bandai USA has also informed
me this model kit will not likely be released in the USA. I purchased the
model kit for my own use and I am unable to watch the DVD on my home DVD
player due to the Region 2 encoding. I feel this is a direct violation of my
rights with this purchase. This is not a grey market import video, nor a
release that will eventually be offered in the USA. Yet, due to the greed of
movie studios and the compliance of consumer electronics firms I cannot view
what I have legally purchased.
