

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1227
OFFERED BY MRS. BIGGERT OF ILLINOIS

At the end of the bill add the following new title:

1 **TITLE V—TENANT-BASED**
2 **RENTAL ASSISTANCE**

3 **SEC. 501. TENANT-BASED RENTAL ASSISTANCE ALLOCA-**
4 **TION FORMULA FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007.**

5 (a) INAPPLICABILITY.—Section 302 of this Act shall
6 not be given any force or effect and the amounts made
7 available for renewals of expiring section 8 tenant-based
8 assistance contracts under the second proviso of section
9 21033 of the Continuing Appropriations Resolution, 2007
10 (Public Law 110-5) shall, notwithstanding the first pro-
11 viso and the third through eighth provisos of such section,
12 be made available in accordance with the provisions of
13 paragraph (1) under the heading “Department of Housing
14 and Urban Development—Public and Indian Housing—
15 Tenant-Based Rental Assistance” in the Transportation,
16 Treasury, Housing and Urban Development, the Judici-
17 ary, the District of Columbia, and Independent Agencies
18 Appropriations Act, 2006 (Public Law 109-115; 119 Stat.
19 2440), except that the first proviso under paragraph (1)

1 of such heading shall be applied for purposes of making
2 amounts available under this subsection by substituting
3 “calendar year 2007”, “2006 annual budget”, and “2007
4 Annual Adjustment Factor” for “calendar year 2006”,
5 “2005 annual budget”, and “2006 Annual Adjustment
6 Factor”, respectively .

7 (b) FISCAL YEAR 2007 FUNDING AMOUNTS.—Sec-
8 tion 21033 of the Continuing Appropriations Resolution,
9 2007 (Public Law 110-5) is amended by inserting before
10 the period at the end the following:

11 “: *Provided further*, That of the amounts available under
12 this section for such heading, the following amounts shall
13 be available for the following purposes specified in para-
14 graphs (2) through (5) under such heading in Public Law
15 109-115 (119 Stat. 2441); for the purposes specified in
16 paragraph (2), \$149,300,000, subject to the limitations in
17 such paragraph, except that additional section 8 tenant
18 protection rental assistance costs may be funded in 2007
19 by using unobligated balances, notwithstanding the pur-
20 poses for which such amounts were appropriated, includ-
21 ing recaptures and carryover, remaining from funds ap-
22 propriated to the Department of Housing and Urban De-
23 velopment under such heading, the heading ‘Annual Con-
24 tributions for Assisted Housing’, the heading ‘Housing
25 Certificate Fund’, and the heading ‘Project-Based Rental

1 Assistance' for fiscal year 2006 and prior fiscal years; for
2 the purpose specified in paragraph (3), \$47,500,000; for
3 the purpose specified in paragraph (4), \$5,900,000; and,
4 for the purpose specified in paragraph (5),
5 \$1,281,100,000, subject to the provisions and limitations
6 of such paragraph, except that the provisions of such para-
7 graph shall be applied in fiscal year 2007 by substituting
8 '\$30,000,000', '\$1,251,100,000', '2007', and '2006' for
9 '\$10,000,000', '\$1,240,000,000', '2006', and '2005', re-
10 spectively, and except that, of the \$30,000,000 made
11 available by this section for allocation to public housing
12 agencies needing additional funds to administer their sec-
13 tion 8 programs, up to \$20,000,000 shall be for fees asso-
14 ciated with section 8 tenant protection rental assistance''.
