## General Information

• **Textbooks:** Books, supplies and other learning materials are mailed to your instructor. Additional items may be purchased for a class by calling the Campus Bookstore at (785) 460-4670.

• **High School Students:** High school students who want to take college courses for credit must submit a form signed by the high school principal stating they have achieved sophomore status and have permission to be enrolled in college classes. Students who are not sophomores must be gifted and submit a current IEP with a recommendation for enrollment in a college course along with the principal permission form. Completion of the COMPASS test is required prior to enrollment in concurrent/dual credit courses.

• **Graduation:** Ceremonies are held in May. Students planning to participate in the ceremony must contact the Campus Bookstore at (785) 460-4670 to order a cap and gown. Students who have met graduation requirements must complete a graduation application and submit it to the Registrar's Office. Degrees are awarded in May, August and December.

• **Outreach Tuition Scholarships:** Scholarships are awarded to students who demonstrate academic success and a commitment to continued learning. Contact your local Community Educational Coordinator for additional information.

• **Withdrawal:** Prompt notification to the Registrar's Office is essential to withdraw from a class. After the second class meeting instructors sign a "WP" or "WF" as a grade for any withdrawal. Call (785) 460-4675 to contact the Registrar. It is the responsibility of the student to complete the withdrawal form and notify the Registrar.

• **Financial Aid:** Application forms are available for private loans, veteran's benefits, Pell Grants or National Direct Student Loans. Call (785) 460-4695 for information and forms. Eligibility for aid is based upon income. Individuals determined eligible to receive aid must be seeking a degree. Proof of high school graduation or GED completion is required.

• **Cancellation or Postponement:** Cancellation or postponement of a class due to inclement weather will be announced on area radio and television stations. Call your instructor or local coordinator by 4 p.m. on the scheduled class day.

• **Continuing Education Seminars:** For nurses, nursing home administrators, social workers, activity directors, counselors, and other health care workers are regularly scheduled throughout northwest Kansas. CEU's are granted for programs. Contact the Allied Health coordinator at (785) 460-5427 for a complete listing of seminars.

• **Retired Senior Volunteer Program:** Provides opportunities for individuals over 55 to remain active by working as volunteers in nonprofit agencies and organizations. More than 400 senior citizens are now working at 60 stations in four northwest Kansas counties. # Tuition and Fees

Tuition and fees are subject to change. In addition, some courses have lab fees which will be indicated with the course.

# EduKan Classes

Colby Community College offers a variety of courses via the Internet. Cost for these courses is \$125 per credit hour, excluding textbooks, regardless of Kansas residency status. # Paramedic Program

The Paramedic (MICT) program prepares students to perform advanced life support skills in the out-of-hospital setting. CCC will be offering courses this year via IDL classes from Garden City Community College. Students who are interested in this program must be certified as an EMT-B in the state of Kansas, be able to pass a criminal background test, and successfully complete ("C" or better) all general education prerequisites. # Placement Testing Policy

To ensure the success of students at CCC, all students are required to take development courses if placement testing has indicated that they are not fully prepared for college work. ***Students are required to take the placement testing prior to enrolling in their first English or math class.*** To meet this challenge, CCC offers a wide variety of development courses in reading and study skills, writing and mathematics. These courses are designed to give students the needed skills to succeed in their college-level classes.

Before students are allowed to enroll in mathematics, English or reading courses they must demonstrate readiness for coursework through their ACT or SAT scores and/or a placement test called COMPASS.

Students who are exempt from placement testing include:

1. Students who have earned a Bachelor's or Associate's degree.
2. Students who have successfully completed ("C" or better) and followed the developmental sequence in math, writing or reading are exempt from the requirements for assessment in that subject only.
3. Students who have successfully completed ("C" or better) a 100-level or above course in English and reading.
4. Students who have successfully completed ("C" or better) a 100-level or above course in mathematics (unless they want to enroll in a higher level math course).
5. Students who have taken the ACT/SAT test within two years prior to enrollment and have scores within the acceptable range (see placement guide). These students are exempt from placement testing in that subject area only. Students must follow the sequence of developmental courses and pass with at least a "C" to move to the next level.

Students may retake COMPASS at a cost of \$5 per section for the following reasons:

1. Students feel placement results do not accurately reflect their abilities.
2. Students feel they have improved their skills through refresher work or previous developmental course work.
3. Students feel the grade received does not reflect their abilities and/or their desire to advance in the course sequence.

### Tuition Grant Expanded to Include Thomas County High School Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors

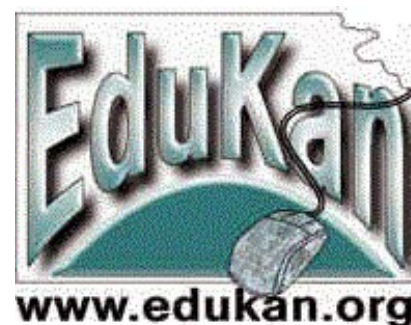
-  High school sophomores, juniors and seniors can earn college credits during regular school day or by enrolling in evening or weekend classes.
