## H.R. 7082 Inmate Tax Fraud Prevention Act of 2008

As cleared by the Congress on October 2, 2008 and signed by the President on October 15, 2008

H.R. 7082 (enacted as Public Law 110-428) allows the Secretary of the Treasury to, under certain circumstances, disclose to the head of the Bureau of Prisons any tax return information with respect to an individual who is incarcerated in a federal prison. It also restores the annuities of certain survivors of judicial officials.

The Joint Committee on Taxation estimates that this act will increase revenues by \$1 million over the 2009-2018 period.

The legislation also will increase direct spending by \$1 million in 2009 and \$2 million between 2009 and 2018 to reinstate the annuities of certain survivors of judicial officials who lost them as a result of remarriage.
