Notes

1. A long vowel is represented in syllabics by a superscript dot, in romanization by doubling the letter (for example, *naaniit* ᓂᓇᐃᑦ; *Kuujjuaq* ຄູັຈູາᖑ).
 2. A circle over a character in the second column converts the vowel from *i* to *aai* (for example, *Aaisaak* ሃଆକ).
