(c) The establishment of an antenna farm area is considered whenever it is proposed by:

- (1) The FAA;
- (2) The Federal Communications Commission;
- (3) The sponsor of a proposed antenna tower; or

(4) Any other person having a substantial interest in a proposed antenna tower.

§ 77.75 Establishment of antenna farm areas.
