Note: Lands under BLM's exclusive jurisdiction are those lands (and resources) managed solely by the Bureau of Land Management. Table includes all unperfected entries except for those involving reclamation and forest homesteads. Differences in fiscal year 1996 acreage from the previous year is due to land acreage acquired by the BLM; exchange land acreage received by the BLM; exchange BLM acreage (surface estate only) patented out by the BLM; withdrawn land acreage restored to BLM's jurisdiction; withdrawals, rights-of-way and easements for which the BLM relinquishes exclusive jurisdiction; or land acreage disposed of by the BLM.
