We strongly support your efforts to restrain Federal spending. The Democrat budget resolution proposes overall discretionary spending of an amount that greatly exceeds what you requested in your FY 2008 budget request. Although the budget resolution can be approved without your signature, spending bills cannot.

Like you, we oppose the large overall increase in Federal spending contained in the FY 2008 budget resolution. Should you veto an FY 2008 appropriations bill because it would contribute to an overall spending level that exceeds your budget request, we will vote to sustain that veto.
