Feeney Commends Nomination of Goss as CIA Chief

(Orlando, FL) - U.S. Rep. Tom Feeney (R-Oviedo) issued the following statement commending President Bush's nomination of U.S. Rep. Porter Goss as Director of the Central Intelligence Agency.

"Porter Goss has served our country's intelligence, military and legislative branches during the span of his impressive career. He is well respected by his colleagues on both sides of the isle and is a valiant leader on Capitol Hill.
