



Program Spending in the Farm Bill Conference Report

The following is a preliminary breakdown of the mandatory spending changes proposed in the Farm Bill. While the Bill only covers 7 years, CBO is scoring the cost of the bill over ten years. CBO assumes that most programs actually continue past 2007. However, CBO does assume that some programs terminate in 2007 (or before). Those programs listed in italics are programs that are not scored as continuing for the entire ten years (unless otherwise noted the program terminates in 2007). If these programs continued, it would increase the cost of the Farm Bill.
