3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Marriage Protection5 Act of 2003".

6 SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON JURISDICTION.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 99 of title 28, United
8 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol9 lowing:

1 "§ 1632. Limitation on jurisdiction

2 "No court created by Act of Congress shall have any jurisdiction, and the Supreme Court shall have no appel-3 late jurisdiction, to hear or determine any question per-4 5 taining to the interpretation of section 1738c of this title. Neither the Supreme Court nor any court created by Act 6 7 of Congress shall have any appellate jurisdiction to hear 8 or determine any question pertaining to the interpretation 9 of section 7 of title 1.".

(b) AMENDMENT TO TABLE OF SECTIONS.—The
table of sections at the beginning of chapter 99 of title
28, United States Code, is amended by adding at the end
the following new item:

"1632. Limitation on jurisdiction.".
