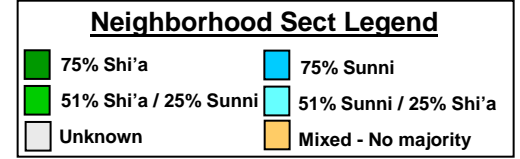

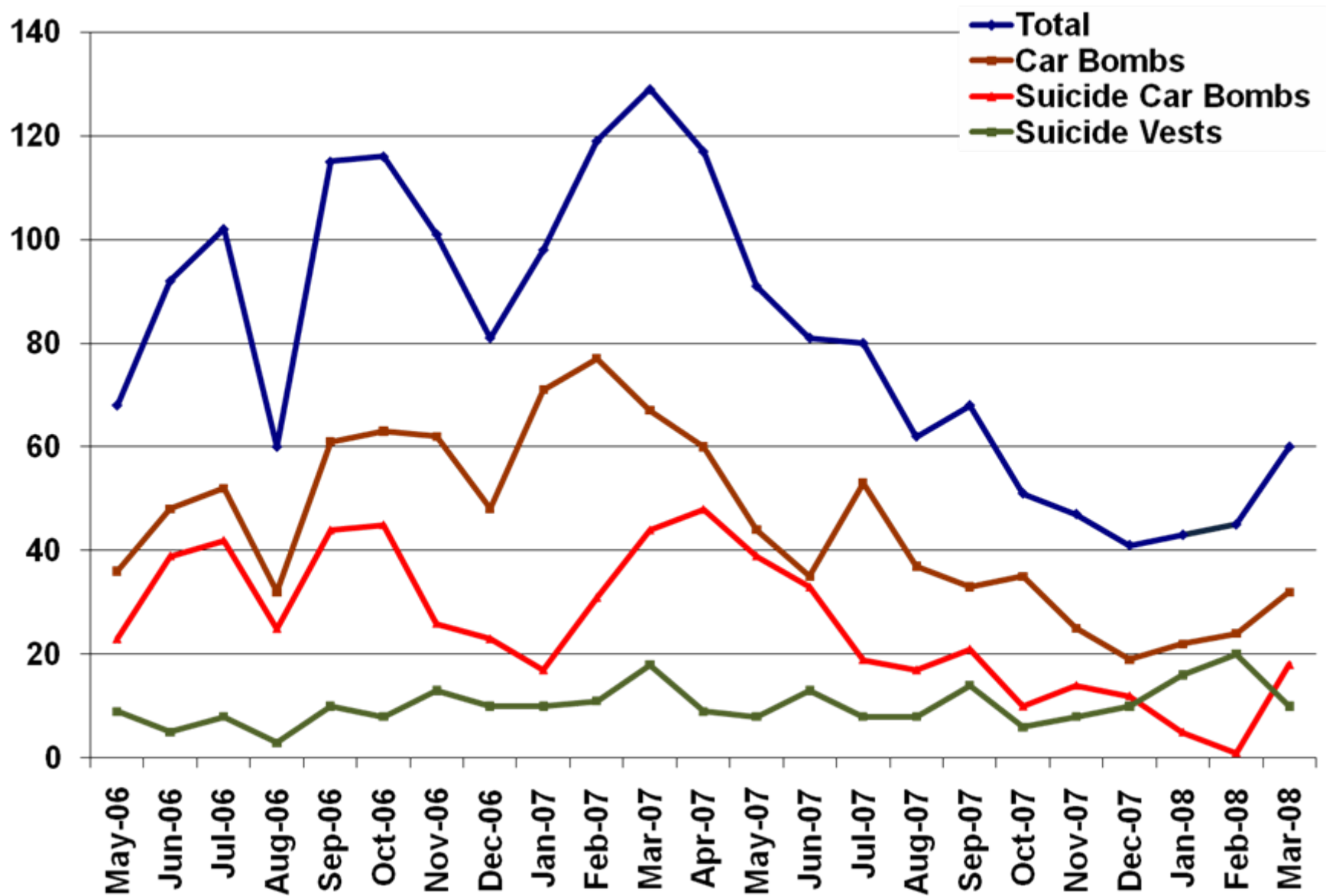
# Ethno-Sectarian Violence
