<p>The NNP Website provides a single source for the information, expertise, and resources emerging from NIDA's primary research and data collection networks. The information includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Map locations and contacts for each network site▪ Network descriptions and missions▪ Links to network websites with research teams, scientific protocols, papers, procedural policies, and manuals▪ NNP Colleagues Directory▪ NIDA news and events of interest	<p>The NNP Website is targeted to anyone with an interest in addiction science, including researchers, practitioners, and policy makers. The NNP currently includes close to 400 members from 14 networks, sponsored by NIDA alone or with Federal partners.</p>
NNP COLLEAGUES DIRECTORY	THE NETWORKS
<p>The NNP Colleagues Directory is a searchable data base of members' expertise and research interest on the NNP Website. When they register, members indicate their Discipline and Research Focus; then others can use those variables to search for help outside of their own expertise. Users can also search by State or ZIP Code to find colleagues from other networks who are located in their city, across the state, or across the country.
