- I. Welcome and Introductions Chair Valerie Durrant welcomed guest Dr. Alfred Johnson, Director of Office of Research Services and two new voting Board members Heather Rogers and Rachel Weinstein. She also welcomed Robert McDonald, the new Office of Facility Resources representative, and Tonya Lee who will be joining the Division of Employee Services as Quality Assurance Specialist for Child Care on October 1.
- II. Report from the Chair Dr. Durrant reported that the Child Care Board Annual Report had been completed in August and would be forwarded to Drs. Zerhouni and Kington via Dr. Johnson. Dr. Durrant thanked Board members Tracy Waldeck and Jayne Lura-Brown for assistance with the Report.
- III. Welcome from ORS Dr. Alfred Johnson thanked Board members for their efforts on behalf of NIH employees and spoke of the importance of NIH child care to NIH. He shared that the Board subsidy report had been approved and that the ORS budget request for FY 2008 had included \$300,000 for the child care subsidy program. The recommendations for subsidy program changes have been reviewed and will be adopted. He thanked the Board for their efforts on behalf of the subsidy program. The Northwest child care center is currently appearing in the FY 2010 Capital budget but it may be eligible for earlier consideration and Dr. Johnson will continue to work with Mr. Dan Wheeland, Director of the Office of Research Facilities to move it forward.

Dr. Johnson spoke of the Child Care Needs Assessment currently under way. ORS is a service organization and, as such, needs to continuously examine what changes need to be made to keep ORS services meaningful and relevant. Child care is very visible and of great concern in Human Capital issues. NIH will face the risk of losing young investigators if their needs cannot be met. The needs assessment is one tool to help NIH gauge the role of child care. Dr. Johnson requested that the Board act as representative stakeholders for all of NIH for the purposes of the needs assessment. Recommendations about child care services that result from the needs assessment will need the support of the Board. Dr. Johnson requested that the Board continue in their role of information and data gathering, as they are the tools he needs to make successful budget requests.

Dr. Johnson also announced reorganization within ORS that will combine the Division of Employee Services with the Division of Travel and Transportation into the Division of Amenities and Transportation services. The new Division will include all of the current programs and services and provide additional staff support.

- IV. Nomination of Board Officers Kim Plascjak, Chair of the Membership Committee, announced that elections for positions of Board Chair and Vice-Chair would be held in November. Dr. Valerie Durrant and Ms. Jayne Lura-Brown have accepted nominations to continue in those offices. Ms. Plascjak will accept additional nominations until November 1, 2007.
- V. Annual Board Orientation Mary Ellen Savarese and Valerie Bonham conducted the annual orientation for all members. They reviewed the roles and responsibility of Board members as well as ethics and reporting requirements. M. Bonham is available for any questions concerning legal/ethics issues. Ms. Savarese can answer questions regarding mechanics of Board operation and work plans.
- **VI. June Minutes -** Chair Durrant called for a vote to approve the minutes from the June, 2007 meeting. Minutes were approved.
- VII. Board Work Plan and Work Year Dr. Durrant led a discussion of the Board Work Plan which was based on discussions from the June, 2007 meeting. The Work Plan is the guide to Board activities this year. The Board Work Year is the month to month plan of how the plan will be accomplished. There was discussion and revision to both documents. Copies of REVSED work Plan and Work Year are attached to these minutes.
- VIII. Committee Appointments Mary Ellen Savarese reviewed committee appointments and accepted new members to committees. A revised copy of that list is attached to these minutes.
- **IX. Announcements -** Executive Child Development Center has achieved Accreditation in the new National Association for the Education of Young children (NAEYC) system. The program and its staff are to be congratulated on this important accomplishment.

- > Prepare and deliver Executive Briefings on the **Economics of Child Care**

- ➤ Understand trends that will affect the NIH changing workforce and employee work life and the role of NIH child care.
- ➤ Identify areas of potential risk for NIH losing key scientific staff.
- > Gather information and participate in the identification of solutions

Resources for a Diverse Employee Population

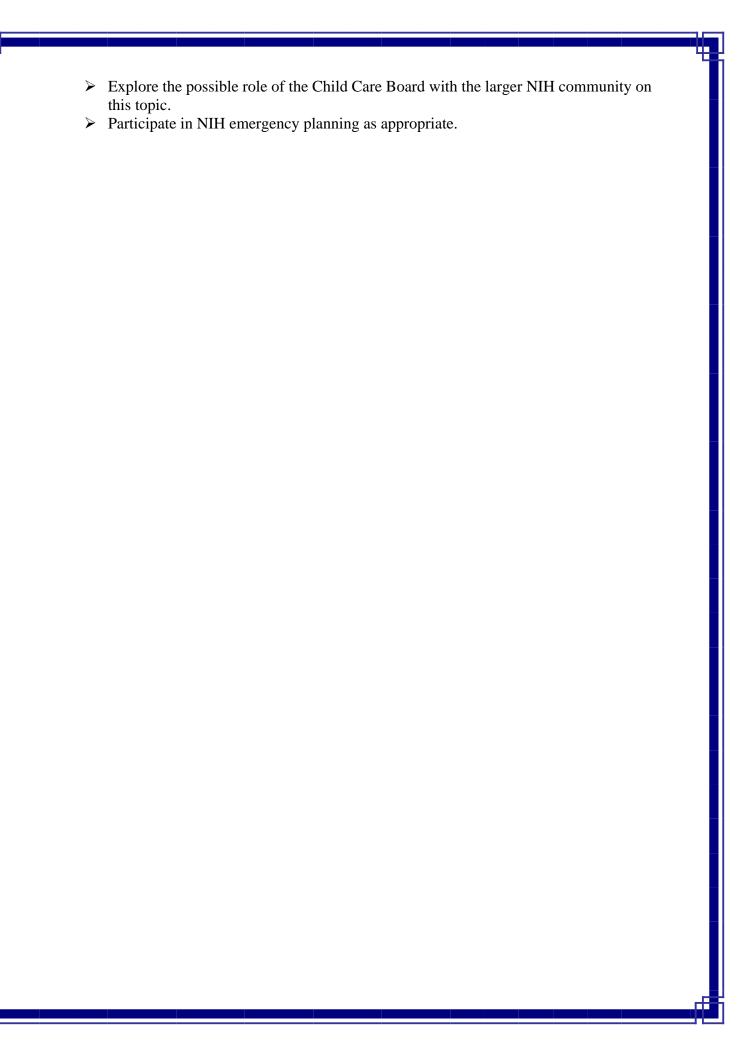
