

Ms. Angela Bates joined the staff of the National Institutes of Health, Office of Research on Women's Health in January 2001 and is the staff lead on issues related to the inclusion of women and minorities in clinical research. She is responsible for ensuring that NIH Institutes and Centers are in compliance with NIH policies for the inclusion of women and minorities as participants in NIH-supported clinical research. In this capacity, Ms. Bates provides technical oversight for preparing comprehensive reports to Congress, conducting analysis of extramural and intramural population data, and providing guidance regarding the requirement for sex/gender analysis as mandated by the Revitalization Act of 1993. Ms. Bates also serves as the ORWH liaison to advocacy groups and other federal agencies on minority women's health issues and is the ORWH lead for information technology projects.
