



- Go Local links on MedlinePlus health topic pages take you to information about health services in local geographic areas – hospitals, physicians, nursing homes, support groups, health screening providers and many others.
- You can link directly from each MedlinePlus health topic to service related to that particular topic. (For example, if you choose Go Local from the MedlinePlus Breast Cancer page, you will find links to local services such as Cancer Clinics, Oncologists and Support Groups in the area you select.)
- NLM partners with libraries and library consortia in this effort. Currently there are 25 Go Local participants, with many more to be released in the future.
- Go Local coverage extends to 49% of U.S. population. (Includes current sites and those in progress.)








ClinicalTrials.gov Visitors by "Role"

DeBakey Science Events


