The words on the front of this card are other names for methamphetamine.

Methamphetamine is a powerfully addictive drug that can produce rapid heart rate, irregular heartbeat, increased blood pressure, and irreversible, stroke-producing damage to small blood vessels in the brain. High body temperature and convulsions occur with overdoses and, if not treated immediately, can result in death.
