

Educate Patients and Families

MedlinePlus offers a wide variety of resources to educate patients and their families on their disease or condition:

- **Handouts** – over 20,000 links to informational and printable web pages, PDFs and other downloadable items
- The **Multiple Languages** link points to information in over 40 languages
- Over 175 **Interactive Tutorials** with simple explanations of conditions and procedures describing health conditions or medical tests in both English and Spanish
- **Easy-to-Read** resources use common words to help patients understand diseases and conditions - see **Health Topics**, lower right-hand corner
- Over 200 links to one-hour **Surgery Videos**, prerecorded webcasts of actual surgical operations with commentary those who want to know
- **Directories** to health professionals, health care providers, and libraries links to **Go Local** information
- **Email Announcement Lists** share new topics added to MedlinePlus
- With **Current Information**
 - **Health Topics** are reviewed twice a year; new links are added daily
 - **News** is updated daily
 - The **Medical Encyclopedia** and **Interactive Health Tutorials** are updated annually

Identify PubMed Articles

To identify articles appropriate for patients and families, MedlinePlus creates a PubMed search which adds (in part) the following code to the topic or disease of interest:

[topic/disease] AND english[la] AND (jsubsetk OR jsubsetn OR jsubsetaim OR patient education handout [pt])
