Release Notes

Version 1.2.5.0 – November 18, 2005

Introduction

The enhancements related to this release of iEdison Officer involve the addition of new features and the correction of several system defects to iEdison II.

Enhancements in this Release

- An enhancement was made to expand the commercial product data to include a flag that will determine whether or not the commercial product is listed on the commercial report. This flag will default to show the commercial product, and the Extramural user cannot change this setting.
- An enhancement was made to expand commercial product data to include the fields "FDA approval number" and "FDA approval type". These fields have a one-to-one relationship with the commercial product. The fields are only required if the user's institution is flagged as requiring these values.
- Expanded the utilization report data so that multiple commercial products can be entered for a utilization report. This enhancement covers the modifications necessary to the Officer application to facilitate this change.

Issues Resolved in this Release

- Previously in iEdison Extramural Web, it was possible for a user to answer "NO" to the question regarding applying for a manufacturing waiver, and enter a non-zero value for the "Total Number of Manufacturing Waivers" without receiving an error. However, in iEdison Officer, the user received an error message (#4243). These items are no longer linked because it may be that the user did not apply for a manufacturing waiver in the current reporting period (and therefore answered "NO"), but the waiver was approved and the user obtained it in this reporting period.
