ALEXANDER ANNOUNCES DHHS FUNDING FOR GRAMBLING STATE UNIVERSITY

DHHS GRANT TOTALS \$30,000

Washington, D.C. -- U.S. Rep. Rodney Alexander, R-Quitman, today announced Grambling State University will receive a grant totaling \$30,000.

The grant, disbursed by the Dept. of Health and Human Services, will be used in a partnership paradigm for reducing obesity and health disease, according to a release by DHHS.

The grant is through a cooperative agreement.

"By investing in health care education, we are working to help make our way of life better," Alexander said. "Grambling State University will take this funding and use it toward health care education, which will benefit north Louisiana."

The awarding office of this grant is the National Institute of Child Health and Human Development.
