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Alexander encourages seniors to sign up for Medicare's Prescription Drug Plan

May 15th deadline approaching quickly

WASHINGTON, D.C.--U.S. Rep. Rodney Alexander, R-Quitman, is encouraging 5th District seniors to sign up for the Medicare Prescription Drug Plan.

The deadline for seniors to sign up is May 15th. To sign up, seniors should either call 1-800-MEDICARE or go online and sign up at www.medicare.gov.

According to recent surveys, over 30 million Americans now have prescription drug coverage. Seniors who enroll in the new benefit are on average saving 50 percent on their much-needed prescription medications. The average beneficiary is expected to save \$1,100 a year.

"This is a last minute chance for some seniors to save on their prescription drug plans," Alexander said. "I ask that 5th District seniors, who qualify for the plan, please consider signing up."
