ALEXANDER, VITTER ANNOUNCE USDA FUNDING

FOREST HILL RECEIVES \$80,000 GRANT

Washington, D.C. -- U.S. Rep. Rodney Alexander, R-Quitman, and U.S. Sen. David Vitter, R-Louisiana, today announced a community facility grant totaling \$80,000 for the Village of Forest Hill.

The grant, disbursed by USDA Rural Development, will be used to purchase an existing school and renovate the facility, which will later be used to house the town hall, police department, a senior citizen center, etc.

"I applaud the Village of Forest Hill for finding creative measures that will improve the quality of life for local residents," Alexander said. "This federal funding will help jump-start this worthy project."

Vitter added, "I'm pleased that USDA Rural Development made this grant available to Forest Hill. This funding will help revitalize a current building to house town services and better meet the needs of Oak Grove residents."
