## **ALEXANDER ANNOUNCES GRANT FUNDING FOR EAST CARROLL AIRPORT AUTHORITY**

*FUNDING TO HELP IMPROVE LOCAL AIRPORT*

Washington, D.C. -- U.S. Rep. Rodney Alexander, R-Quitman, today announced that the Federal Aviation Administration will award the East Carroll Airport Authority with a grant totaling \$144,444.

The grant will be used to remove trees that currently penetrate approaches to the Byerley Airport, according to the FAA.

"This funding will help improve the conditions of the East Carroll Airport," Alexander said.

"It is imperative that the federal government continues investing in infrastructure improvements, like the East Carroll Airport Authority, because it has the potential to benefit our local economies."
