ALEXANDER, VITTER ANNOUNCE USDA FUNDING FOR CATAHOULA HOSPITAL SERVICE DISTRICT 1

GRANT FUNDING TOTALS \$73,500

Washington, D.C. -- U.S. Rep. Rodney Alexander, R-Quitman, and U.S. Sen. David Vitter, R-La., today announced that the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) has approved a grant totaling \$73,500.

The grant, disbursed by the Community Facility Loan and Grant Economic Impact Initiative, will allow Catahoula Hospital Service District 1 to make roof repairs to the Catahoula Medical Complex.

"The Catahoula Medical Complex is essential to the residents of Catahoula Parish," Alexander said. **"This grant funding will allow the hospital to make necessary repairs."**

Vitter added, **"The Catahoula Medical Complex offers critical services to the community. This federal funding will enable the complex to make much-needed repairs to its roof allowing it to continue providing quality medical service."**
