ALEXANDER, VITTER ANNOUNCE USDA FUNDING FOR TOWN OF JONESVILLE

GRANT FUNDING TOTALS \$82,540

Washington, D.C. -- U.S. Rep. Rodney Alexander, R-Quitman, and U.S. Sen. David Vitter, R-La., today announced that the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) has approved a grant totaling \$82,540 for the Town of Jonesville.

The grant, disbursed by the Community Facility Loan and Grant Economic Impact Initiative, will go toward the purchase of a new fire truck for the Town of Jonesville.

"This will enhance the capabilities of the Town of Jonesville," Alexander said. "This grant funding will help our first responders save lives."

Vitter added, "I am pleased the U.S. Department of Agriculture recognized the needs of the Jonesville Fire Department. A new fire truck is vital for these firefighters to continue protecting the community."
