## **ALEXANDER, VITTER ANNOUNCE USDA FUNDING FOR TOWN OF JONESVILLE**

**GRANT FUNDING TOTALS \$82,540**

Washington, D.C. -- U.S. Rep. Rodney Alexander, R-Quitman, and U.S. Sen. David Vitter, R-La., today announced that the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) has approved a grant totaling \$82,540 for the Town of Jonesville.

The grant, disbursed by the Community Facility Loan and Grant Economic Impact Initiative, will go toward the purchase of a new fire truck for the Town of Jonesville.

**"This will enhance the capabilities of the Town of Jonesville,"** Alexander said. **"This grant funding will help our first responders save lives."**

Vitter added, **"I am pleased the U.S. Department of Agriculture recognized the needs of the Jonesville Fire Department. A new fire truck is vital for these firefighters to continue protecting the community."**
