iRIS – Grants Assistant™ is one of several modules that can be purchased as a stand-alone, web-based application or integrated into our iRIS™ (integrated Research Information System) suite which includes Study Assistant, IACUC Assistant, Compliance Assistant and Review Board Assistant which includes IRB, IBC, COI, Radiation safety, GCRC, Pharmacy review committees. Grants Assistant™ assists researchers in proposal development, electronically routing for review and approvals and assists with the completion of all required forms.

Grants Assistant will be offered as an affordable standalone application and a comprehensive grants management system by July/August of 2006.

Grants Assistant is a web-based application and supports most web-browsers and platforms. When integrated with our iRIS suite, information is shared between modules which helps eliminate data redundancy. Forms are inserted with merge codes to pull existing data out of the database and into the forms, saving time and effort. Other features include:

- A user-friendly interface to easily guide the researcher through the submission process.
- Audit tracking of proposal creation, review and submission (within your institute and to Grants.gov).
- Configurable interface to assign roles and security levels for all staff members
- Automated email reminders
- Submission History log similar to a FedEx tracking receipt
- Multiple budget support
- Document management system
- Error checking and validation
- Configurable workflow to route submission through your internal review and

approval process
