## <sup>1)</sup> Will the SP be required to input data into SYSFAS, if so to what detail?

The SP would be responsible for inputting job data into ssfas. The extent would be receiving the job, charging the X# in ssfas, tracking the job in ssfas if needed, maintaining the unbilled jobs report, etc. The SP doesn't need certification to operate ssfas, but the sp would be required to take the delpro class to learn the operation of ssfas.

The preparation and workflow of data into ssfas is a necessary component of providing the service. SSFAS is required, for the SP to interface

with NIH mandated internal business processes and systems. . CIT (IMS Help Desk) should be able to train or assist with the introduction to ssfas and existing staff may also be a resource.

This would not be an issue with the events services and video services since we stated in the solicitation that the resource management system

is ScheduAll from which the monthly billing file for transfer to the CAS is being prepared by the SP.
