On behalf of the ICCVAM, we are pleased to provide you with the recently published "ICCVAM Guidelines for the Nomination and Submission of New, Revised, and Alternative Test Methods," NIH Publication No. 03-4508 (Attachment 1). This document is the second revision to guidelines originally published in 1998. It provides updated guidance to test method sponsors and nominators on the information needed by ICCVAM to evaluate the validation status of new or revised test methods at any stage of development and after the completion of validation studies. It also includes a framework for organizing information supporting the validity of a test method.

New additions to this document include a chapter on the ICCVAM test method nomination and submission process, and a chapter on performance standards for test methods.
