after Mr Fillmore was Vice President  
'dremain the morning over. when  
so many Senators rise to offer petitions,  
the Senator annoyed him so much  
that he called me up to him and  
said Bassett I want you to take

this tabel. I cannot understand

~~if~~ if Page happen to be out. (then was but 2  
two Pages in those days) he would leave his  
seat and walk up to the Vice  
President's desk, take a pinch and  
return to his seat, and go on with  
his Speech - it all way created a  
Laughter, now Matter how crowded  
the floor was, the Ladies would  
get up and let him pass: in those  
day Ladies was admitted to the floor

gave me a Gold Snuff Box to  
keep safe and place on the desk

expired as Vice President just as he left  
the Vice President Chair, he grabbed  
up the Box put it in his pocket  
and forgot to give me the fifty  
cents, for the last week - he left the

Senator Bibb. of Kentucky  
was a grot Snuffer he carried his  
Box in his hands most of the time he  
was in the Senate Chamber

Senata Thurman of Ohio  
was also a grot Snuffer, one one  
occasion when he was making a  
speech in the Senate. his Snuff  
Box gave out. he Coaxed a Page  
and gave it to him to carry to  
Capt Basset. and tell him to  
fill it and send it back to

and handed it to the Page he Carried  
it and gave it to the Senator

then Went over with his  
Speech —

Senator Phelps of Vermont  
was an ex man snuff taker  
I have often seen him Com
