

The Demand – Why / What

Today ... 1 in 3 civilian scientific and technical workers in defense department can retire NOW

2008 ... 1 in 4 U.S. aerospace workers will be eligible to retire

2010 ... A&D Industry can replace only about half of the 57,000 – 68,000 engineers who will retire (assumes no growth)

2015 ... 70% of the current air traffic controllers will become eligible to retire

2017 ... 30,000 – estimated shortfall of pilots employed at major U.S. airlines

March 9, 2007 ... Bill Gates: "The U.S. should double the number of science, technology and math graduates
