

- Excessive Drawdowns
- Large Available Balances
- Appropriation Monitoring
- Reporting Requirements
- Grant Closeouts

Department of Education Awards FY 2006

FY 2006 - All ED Awards

- 832 Awards
- \$306,628,279

FY 2006 - Strengthening Institutions

- 94 Awards
- \$94,843,623

ED's Drawdown Policy

- Draw down only enough cash to meet grant's immediate need
- Minimize time between drawdown and pay out of funds



Rule of thumb:

Rate of drawdown must be commensurate with approved scope of work and milestones

Large Available Balances

- Within 90 days, "flags" grants with 70% or more of funds remaining
- ****** Clarification required before issuing continuation award

Appropriation Monitoring

31 U.S.C. 1552(a)

- Account available for a definite period canceled Sept. 30 five fiscal years after its availability for federal obligation ends
- Remaining balances in the account revert to
 Treasury the following day, Oct. 1
 - **\$2,143,404** (as of 4/02/2007)

⇒ \$5,975,605

Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act of 2006 (FFATA)

- President signed bill on Sept. 26, 2006
- Searchable website for public to search funding by data elements
 - Be able to ascertain amount of federal funding awarded to an entity
 - Be able to download results of search

- *Who* ~ <u>new project directors</u> and <u>business officers</u>
 - ~ refresher for experienced staff
- What ~ training materials <u>resources/pubs</u> ED grant office home page links
- When ~ 24 OPEN
- Where ~ wherever you have computer access
- Why ~ responsible/effective project management -- avoid costly mistakes

On-line Grantee Training

- Grantee's major responsibilities
- Monitoring activities to evaluate grantee's performance
 - when performance conferences will take place
 - performance reports and when to submit them
- Site visits <u>compliance</u> and technical <u>assistance</u>
- Fiscal management and recordkeeping
- Four <u>administrative</u> <u>actions</u> permitted via "expanded authority"
