## THE FOLLOWING REQUESTS WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR FY2008 ONLY!

Cage washers, rack washers, bottle washers, autoclaves and ventilated bedding dump facilities.

## AND/OR

High density racks with individually ventilated cages. Each request will be allowed to include a set of primary cages and one set of changing cages per rack.

## PLEASE CAREFULLY NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

Dollar for dollar matching will not be required for Animal Facility Equipment Requests.

- Full submission packages per handbook requirements shall be required by the deadline. Only (2) two complete paper copies are to be submitted to VACO.
- ➤ The LAMb program will NOT consider for funding the following elements of any proposal:

Service contracts

Installation, deinstallation, and removal of existing equipment Site preparation requirements

Markups due to contracting requirements at the facility

A commitment letter from the facility engineering service (138) must be provided for all major equipment requests outlining how these services (installation, de-installation, removal and preparation of the site) will be provided at the facility.

- There will be no construction funds available to support the Animal Equipment program.
- Site visits may be used to gain a better understanding of the facilities' major equipment needs.
