USAF Headquarters AMC and Interior's NBC Sign MOU to Share Air Carrier's Safety Information

Government Agencies Aim to Improve Safety and Efficiency of Civil Air Carrier's Providing Service to the US Government

Washington DC – The National Business Center (NBC) Aviation Management Directorate (AMD) under the Department of Interior recently signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the United States Air Force Headquarters Air Mobility Command (AMC) Commercial Airlift

Division.
