

- Composite Health Summary
- Master patient index
- Central database
- Demographics research
- Statewide registries
- Share with State PHNs
 - Immunizations



MFI-The Bad

- 3 staff & part of a programmer
- Before LOINC and NDC Drug Codes
- Before HL7
- No security standards
- No RPMS certification
- Only RPMS to RPMS
- Millions of records
- Codes out of synch
- No version control

MFI-The Ugly


