\*\*Summary of Major Collections of National Committee Records at Presidential Libraries  
Most of the DNC and RNC records are currently maintained at the presidential libraries. The practice was started under Franklin Roosevelt and continued informally until 1978, when the Democratic and Republican parties entered into agreements with the National Archives for the preservation of their permanently valuable historical materials. Under the 1978 agreement, the two political parties will retire their records to the National Archives and retain authority over them for a period of ten years. During the ten year period only persons authorized by the party will be

permitted to examine the records, and after that time the records will be open to the public. The records will be housed in the National Archives building or at a presidential library.
