3,3'-Dichlorobenzidine dihydrochloride ([1,1'-biphenyl]-4,4'-diamino, 3,3'-dichloro-) (CAS No. 612-83-9) (provided for in subheading 2921.59.80).

Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:

The subject product is an aromatic diamine salt that is used as a precursor in the production of various yellow pigments that are used in the printing ink industry. Historically, it may have been imported from Japan, Korea, China, India, and Switzerland, among other countries.

Technical comments:⁴

The Commission staff suggests that the existing heading, 9902.25.73, be used for the new duty suspension by changing the rate of duty from "5.9%" to "Free" and by modifying the effective date.

⁴ The Commission may express an opinion on the HTS classification of a product to facilitate consideration of the bill. However, by law, only the U.S. Customs Service is authorized to issue a binding ruling on this matter. The Commission believes that the U.S. Customs Service should be consulted prior to enactment of the bill.
